Our hearts grow heavy when we receive phone calls from CPS of children being abandoned on the streets, children being malnourished, children naked or dirty, children without parents caring for them. These were the stories of 11 children this month at different times being washed and clothed at Harvest House. Our shelters and foster families are full and our children have no homes to go too. Harvest Baptist Church answered the call to 6 of the children needing an emergency homes. Coming May, for National Foster Care Month, Harvest House will highlight the need to foster on Guam.
