Annual Events



We were able to host 78 foster children and 35 foster families at this event.

Back 2 School Supply Stash - In August, Harvest House was able to give out 325 backpacks to our foster children during the Back 2 School Supply Stash thanks to all our community donors. Foster families also got to fellowship, enjoy sweet treats, and make cool Lego creations throughout the event!

Orphan Sunday - In November, Harvest House was able to present on the biblical call to care for the fatherless at Harvest Baptist Church. On Orphan Sunday, we take time to learn about our island's need for loving foster families and encourage the church to examine themselves to see how they can help care for those in need.

Christmas Celebration- In December, we hosted nearly 300 foster children and over 100 families at our "Christmas Morning" event. Families enjoyed Christmas presents, a breakfast station, and other holiday activities! Since the event, we have been able to give out nearly 2,000 gifts to the foster community!





Our Services

Recruit, Irain, and Retain Foster Families

With over 600 children in the foster care system and less than 80 licensed foster families on Guam, our hope is to share the great need for foster homes and to equip parents with the skills needed care of them. Through informational meetings, we have hosted 60 potential foster parents. We have also provided monthly Trauma Treatment Foster Parent Training through the Pressley Ridge curriculum. In addition, Harvest House provides respite care, support meetings, special days, and annual events in effort to retain our licensed foster families and prevent burnout. With the help of our community, we hope to continue these efforts for the year ahead.
